Terms of Sale

The buyer and seller understand and agree to the following conditions of sale:

- 1) This specific Cat has been held for the Buyer based on a deposit of _____. Buyer understands the deposit paid is non-refundable but can be transferred to another cat of the same litter (if available), or any future litter. The buyer agrees to pay the remaining balance of _____ prior to taking possession of the Cat.
- 2) LIMITED WARRANTY: The Cat must be given a health check by a licensed veterinarian within three (3) business days of receiving the Cat. Buyer is responsible for entire vet bill. If any serious or life-threatening health issues are found, Buyer has two (2) business days following the veterinary exam to notify the Seller and request a replacement for the Cat. This request MUST accompany a letter from your veterinarian stating why the Cat's health is in question. If Buyer fails to comply with any aspect of this agreement, Buyer forfeits any rights they may otherwise have.

- 3) Seller will not be held responsible for any type of common feline infections known to affect cats beyond the 72-hour health guarantee. Buyer agrees there are common infections in cats and these are beyond the control of the Seller. If Buyer finds a problem with the Cat after the 72-hour veterinarian exam, Buyer agrees to allow Seller to contact the Buyer's veterinarian.
- 4) GENETIC GUARANTEE: The Cat is guaranteed against fatal genetic or congenital defects for **four (4) years** from the date of this contract. The Cat is covered for **two (2) years against FIP**. If the Cat should die or be destroyed due to a genetic defect during this period, Seller agrees to replace the Cat with the next available cat of like quality, upon being provided with a necropsy report from a licensed, impartial veterinary pathologist or veterinary records indicating diagnoses from at least two (2) different veterinarians (not in the same practice) prior to death. The necropsy report must state that death was unquestionably a genetic or congenital defect. Seller will not be responsible for any shipping or transportation costs.
- 5) If Buyer is purchasing the Cat as a show quality cat, Buyer may show the Cat in shows; however, the Seller makes no representations or guarantees.
- 6) As part of this sales contract, Buyer acknowledges the following:
 - a. The Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP) vaccination is controversial, with some studies showing the vaccine to be dangerous. By giving the Cat this vaccine, any and all health guarantees in this agreement become null and void. We do not recommend the Feline Leukemia (FELV) vaccine due to the chance for vaccine associated sarcomas. However, your vet can let you know if they feel this vaccination is in your cat's best interest.
 - b. De-clawing is a major surgery on a cat that removes the first knuckles of a cat's paws, which has led to behavioral problems and health issues. Buyer understands that in no circumstance is the Cat to be de-clawed. If the de-clawing procedure is performed, Buyer assumes all responsibility for the health and behavioral issues afterwards and does not hold Seller responsible.
 - c. The Cat cannot be allowed to roam outdoors unattended or supervised, there is too much risk, and Buyer agrees the Cat will be kept indoors only.
 - d. The Cat will not be given any over the counter or prescription medication without a veterinarian's written understanding and approval. Giving any medication without the approval of a veterinarian will void any and all health guarantees in this agreement.
 - e. The Cat will be kept free from pests such as fleas, ear-mites, fungus, worms, etc. by using products like Revolution (recommended), Advantage, or Frontline.
- 7) Allergic reaction to the Cat is the responsibility of the Buyer, but Seller will assist Buyer in finding new home for cat, with limited or no reimbursement or refund to Buyer.
- 8) If for any reason Buyer becomes unwilling or unable to keep the Cat and provide the Cat with proper food, shelter, and medical attention, Buyer agrees to surrender the Cat to Seller, unconditionally, with no reimbursement or refund to Buyer.

- 9) In the event of a sudden or unexplained death, Buyer agrees to provide Seller with an autopsy report by a licensed veterinary pathologist. Seller, at their own discretion, may replace the Cat after the genetic guarantee has expired. The Cat's full medical history must be supplied to Seller.
- 10) Any legal fees incurred by failing to comply with the above conditions will be the responsibility of the Buyer and will be filed and governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma, as well as Tulsa County.
- 11) If Seller finds it in the best interest of the Cat, Seller has a right to cancel this contract and refund all monies paid before Buyer takes possession of the Cat.

This contract is a binding legal document. Buyer agrees to provide all medical records and properly signed registration papers should the cat have to be surrendered back to the Seller due to breach of contract, with no reimbursements to Buyer.
